

Frequently asked questions

Celebrate Summer Camp 2010

Can I sign up for individual one week sessions?

Yes. Each one-week session is \$85.00

Can my current 6th grader (7th grader in the Fall) attend?

Absolutely!

Why do we need to provide the camp with medical/physical forms?

The Topsfield Board of Health requires the camp to have current medical information on all campers. This information allows the staff to properly tend to each campers medical needs, whether routinely or in an emergency. This information is kept confidential and stored securely on site. Attendance will be denied if this information is not provided.

Can children from towns other than Topsfield attend?

Yes. The camp is geared toward children in the TriTown area (Boxford, Middleton and Tospfield). However, children from nearby communities are welcome to attend.

Does the camp provide campers with lunch?

No. Campers are encouraged to bring snacks and/or lunch, which don't need to be refrigerated. There are breaks during the day for campers to have a snack or lunch. There is also a Camp Store where campers can purchase light snacks and beverages.

What types of activities are campers engaged in?

Campers rotate among activities in four major areas: Arts & Crafts, Sports, Science & Nature exploration and Drama/Imagination. Campers will also participate less structured activities such as board games, playground games, and just good ol' rest, if they need it.

How can I get in touch with the camp staff during the day?

The Camp Director, Maggie Bridgeo, has a cell phone used exclusively for the camp. She will make that number available to all parents on the first day of every session.

Can I get a refund if our child cannot attend after we signed up?

No refunds will be made after the enrollment deadline of June 4, 2010. You may request your tuition to be credited to another week, if there is space available.
