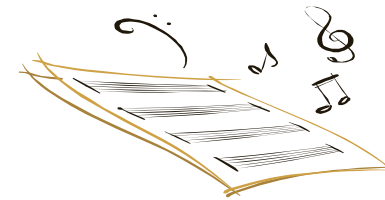


CONCERTS ON THE COMMON

July 11 – Dick Kaplan Band – Considered among the finest Traditional Jazz Players in America, this is a very lively, people-friendly ensemble performing Great American Swing, Jazz and Patriotic Favorites. Their music is high-energy, happy, very uplifting, and appealing to people of all ages! The Dick Kaplan Band has appeared in many venues throughout New England.

July 18 – Merrimack Valley Concert Band - The Merrimack Valley Concert Band is a traditional community concert band, based in West Newbury, MA, consisting solely of people who love music. It's really that simple. "We love to play and perform from "[The Great American Songbook](#)" in its broadest interpretation." *This concert is supported by a grant from the Topsfield Cultural Council, a local agency funded by the Massachusetts Cultural Council, a state agency.*

July 25 – Macey & Hart – Performing live acoustic hits from the 50's through today for over 30 years. Tim Hart and Joe Macey say of their band: "We make our music the old fashioned way..... from years of study and practice to master our instruments, to a musical friendship lasting over 30 years..... we are the real deal sharing a common love of music, our fans, and the willingness to still care about making people happy through one of the world's most powerful mediums known as music."

August 1 – Jumpin' Juba – They play a mix of old-school blues, rock & roll, and roots-y versions of Americana tunes. Steve Hurl sings, and bends the guitar strings, Bruce Ward pounds the piano keys, Brian Flan knocks out the beat. Their 1st CD, **Bumpity Bump**, got great reviews in the press, and on the 'net, and play on many hip radio shows. Their follow-up CD, **Slap Happy**, has just been released. Upbeat music suitable for listening, dining (like, barbecue), and especially, dancing.

August 8 – Yankee Notions – Treat yourself and your audience to the best in traditional and contemporary New England folk music! Jim Douglas and Tim Van Egmond are accomplished singers, storytellers, and musicians. Performing throughout New England for close to 20 years, this group has been featured in hundreds of community concerts and festivals, schools, libraries senior centers, and heritage museums. *This concert is partially supported by a grant from the Topsfield Cultural Council, a local agency funded by the Massachusetts Cultural Council, a state agency.*

August 15 – Reunion – A four man cover band that spans four decades of the fabulous music you grew up with – Beatles, Stones, Animals, Van Morrison, Rascals, Monkees, Eagles – the greatest artists' songs from the 50's, 60's, 70's and 80's. Reunion will take you back with a "Blast from the Past".

August 22 – Chris Marino Sings – A unique and charismatic vocalist with a multi keyboard back up performing Classic Rock, Ballads and Blues from the 60's and 70's from the likes of Janis Joplin to Sarah McLaughlin, Willie Nelson to Rod Stewart, Led Zeppelin, Procol Harem and more... Also, a special guest appearance by the "Still", 2 singing guitar players performing songs by: The Grateful Dead, The Band, Bob Dylan, Johnny Cash....

August 29 – The Renowns – Boston's Premier vocal group featuring music from the 50's, 60's and 70's, as well as some original songs. This group originally started in 1962, when most of its members were in High School, but disbanded in 1966. In 2003, the group reunited and recorded their first CD album "**Reunion**". Their second CD "**Now Appearing**" was released on June 26, 2009.
